The band is pleased to announce that the special guest of the Pirmās dienas tūre will be the young and talented Chris Noah, whose hits “Cik tālu vēl?”, “Nomodā” and “Kādreiz” have topped Latvian radio charts, while his album Atvadas nav skumjas, ja zinām, ka drīz tiksimies led to two sold-out concerts at the “Palladium” concert hall.
