

The Labrags Beach

The Labrags Beach is located at the mouth of the Rīva River.

To the northeast of Pāvilosta, one can enjoy breathtaking views of the grey dunes, while only a couple of kilometres further – one of the most beautiful sections the Baltic Coastal Hiking Route with outstanding bluffs with a total length of more than 20 km. The most interesting bluff scenery can be seen near Strante and Ulmale villages and the estuary of the Rīva River. In the summer, orchids bloom at many places on the lower part of coastal landslides. In Jūrkalne and in its surroundings, one can enjoy “two sunsets” – the first one from the beach and the second one – from the top of the bluff a couple of moments later.

At this recreation area, there are:

- Access road.
- Boat ramp.
- Benches.
- Picnic table.
