



# The new tourism edition of 2023 “Enjoy the summer in Ventspils!” is available.

Ventspils Tourism Information Centre (TIC) has traditionally published the most up-to-date tourism information publication of the year “Enjoy the summer in Ventspils!”, which publishes information about the biggest summer events in the city, tourism news, recreation and entertainment opportunities, as well as the city’s most beautiful places for walking and upcoming projects.

The tourism edition invites travelers to enjoy their summer holidays in Ventspils, offering a diverse program of events. The most anticipated event of this year is the opening of the **all-season toboggan track**. Its total run length is 580 m, which will be located in the territory of the Adventure Park and ski hill “Lemberga hute”. During the ride there will be an opportunity to develop a speed of 40km/h. A grand opening is scheduled for June 10!

The publication also offers the most up-to-date summer offer at the city’s tourist attractions, choose a suitable entertainment for relaxing with children or give preference to viewing the museum of interest. News of the tourist season – the **environmental object “Lats”** unveiled on the mound of the Livonian Order, as a tribute to our national currency; The new **Kurzeme Rehabilitation Centre** offers more than 100 medical rehabilitation services- salt room and therapeutic gymnastics in Latvia in a unique pool with a lifting floor; The new **community centre** in **Gāliņciems**, which will become home to a wide range of cultural events.

A little insight is also available about the city’s future objects – the construction of a **bicycle park** with two asphalt bicycle races of different lengths, a gravel adventure bicycle race and several recreation areas in Ventspils Renķa Garden, as well as the creation of an **indoor skate park and volleyball court**Kr.Valdemāra iela 12A.

Still relevant in Ventspils is the possibility of using the local non-monetary monetary unit – ventu in the tourist attractions of the city. With vents it is possible to get up to 50% discount on tea in 40 rest, sightseeing and entertainment venues in Ventspils. TIC offers everyone interested a wide range of tourism expenses, in which you can find information about Ventspils tourist attractions, accommodation and catering opportunities. On the routes developed by the “Cycling Route Map” and “Walking Map” you can see the most beautiful places of the city, t.sk. flower sculptures, 28 sculptures of cows and 10 sparkling fountains. There is also a tourist map “Ventspils right bank”, which includes sightseeing from the center of Pārventa all the way to Lake Būšnieki. The centre also offers a wide range of tourism materials in the city’s surroundings – Ventspils region, Kurzeme and other regions of Latvia, as well as some publications that invite you to travel within the Baltic States – “Baltic Coastal Hiking Route”, “Forest Trail”, “Military Heritage”, “Industrial Heritage”, etc.
