The offers by the Seaside Open-Air Museum, Castle of the Livonian Order and House of Crafts will help to look closer at the history of Ventspils, as well as to stay informed about upcoming events.

In our Adventure Park you can try yourself and discover adrenaline sensation in our new all-season Toboggan Run. Lovers of winter fun are welcome on the ski hill 'Lemberga hūte' and on the Skating Rink of the Ice Hall. Our Water Amusement Park is open for everyone who wants to warm up in the cold weather and have a fun day.

There, you will also find a call to achieve, get and use Ventspils currency – Vents – that can be spent in places of attraction around the city. Using vents, you can get up to 50% discount in approximately 40 places of recreation, sightseeing, and entertainment in Ventspils.

The new Ventspils tourism guide is published in three language – Latvian, Russian and Lithuanian and its overall print-run is 180000 copies. The tourism guide is available at the Tourism Information Centre and at touristic places around the city. In addition, readers of various newspapers will get a printed version of the Ventspils tourism guide as a free supplement inside Latvian-language newspapers Diena and Kurzemes vārds, as well as in the magazines Ieva and Privātā dzīve. The supplement is also available in the Russian-language newspapers Суббота, Сегодня Неделя and МК Latvija and in the Lithuanian newspaper Lietuvas Rytas.
