Two young and promising teachers of the piano department of the Ventspils Music High School – Olga Trubenko and Andrejs Grīnbergs – will play in the concert. Both pianists took part in the Jāzeps Vītolas 8th International Pianist Competition this autumn with good success, which means that both are in the best technical shape and have invested the maximum amount of time and effort in preparing concert programs under the guidance and support of their professors. The concert will show the performance of Ventspils pianists at the moment when they are best prepared.

About his student Andrej’s performance in the competition, Juris Žvikovs, professor of the piano department of the Jāzeps Vītola Academy of Music, writes as follows: “..a big thank you to my student Andrej Grīnbergs for the great pleasure of showing the best version of himself as a pianist-musician in two rounds of the competition. What better can a teacher wish for!”.

Looking forward to the concert, Olga Trubenko expresses: “I am especially happy for the opportunity to perform at home, on the stage of the “Latvija” concert hall with an extensive solo program, share beautiful music from different eras and enjoy the moment with the audience. It is also a great pleasure to perform in a wonderful company with Andrejs Mārtins Grīnbergs. Let’s spend autumn together!”.

On the other hand, Andrejs Grīnbergs expresses himself as follows: “I think, together with Olga, this Chamber Music Days event will not only be a concert, but also a kind of reference point – we prepared the pieces included in our programs for the 8th International Jāzep Vītolas Piano Competition in October of this year. It will be a report (no matter how scary, businesslike and scary – businesslike this word may sound) not only for teachers, students and listeners, but also for themselves. The main difference probably lies in the fact that we will prepare these compositions less for the competition situation, but rather with warmth and sincere gratitude to the school where we both studied, graduated and where we have started work. The opportunity to share what you have done with your loved ones is probably one of several formulas for happiness”.

The invitation to play on the stage of the “Latvija” concert hall is a recognition of young teachers for their courage and efforts in preparing for an international competition and an encouragement for creative work in the future.

About musicians

Olga Trubenko is a graduate of Ventspils Music High School. Studied piano with teacher Ludmila Kamisheva, while simultaneously learning the organ. Currently studying at the Jāzeps Vītolas Academy of Music of Latvia, prof. Jura Kalnciema’s piano class. She works at the Ventspils Music High School as a concertmaster and teacher. Laureate of several international and national competitions, as well as a participant of organ festivals and competitions. She has participated in master classes with such pianists as Shu Nings, Antuāns Buvī, Nino Žvanija, Žans Millers, Zbignevas Ibelgaupas, Juris Žvikovs, Andrejs Osokins.

Andrejs Grīnbergs was born in Rīga. Graduated from the piano class of Andy Renemanis at the Ventspils Music High School, while also optionally studying composition with Andras Dzenis. He is currently studying piano at the Jāzeps Vītolas Academy of Music of Latvia with assoc. prof. Jura Žvikova, on the other hand, works as a teacher and concert master at the Ventspils Music High School.

Laureate of several piano and composition competitions, participated in master classes with artists such as Asija Ahmetzhanova, Antoine Bouvy, László Fassang, William Goldstein, Ivāri Ilja, Tatjana Korsunskaja, Igors Lazko, Peter Máté, Sandra Mogensen (Sandra Mogensen), John Mortensen (John Mortensen), Andrejs Osokins, Reinis Zariņš and others.
