Actors Andris Bērziņš, Edgars Pujāts, and Imants Strads come together for the concert program “Nerātņi joki un dziesmas” (“Playful Jokes and Songs”).

This autumn, a lively concert program, “Playful Jokes and Songs,” featuring popular actors Andris Bērziņš, Edgars Pujāts, and Imants Strads, will tour across Latvia.

As the artists promise, the concerts will feature plenty of spicy jokes drawn from real life, engaging conversations with the audience, and discussions about the works of the popular Danish cartoonist Herluf Bidstrup (1912–1988), who is also well-known in Latvia.

“Money” from Brālī Laiviniekī’s repertoire

And more beloved songs.
